Every member has the right and duty under the Occupational Health and Safety Act (section 32) to report aggressive and/or violent behaviours. The form (A4071) is available in every school and can be downloaded from the SCEOT website. Insist on follow up from administration within 3 working days after filing, and notify your Federation immediately if the process does not work to your satisfaction. Of course, notify your Federation immediately in the event you sustain an injury, no matter how minor, as a result of aggressive behaviour. Remember, if you let it happen to you, you guarantee that it will happen to someone else.

The duty to protect is everyone's responsibility AND it is the law in Ontario.
