Hello SCEOT members!

My apologies on the April ON CALL being sent in May, however I was waiting on important information to share with you! ELHT benefits are FINALLY available to SCEOT members AND the Collective Agreement is available as well!!!

[ELHT \(Employee Life and Health Trust\)](#) enrolment emails have FINALLY been sent out to eligible LTO members. There are still glitches with the costing so I want to remind you that a 1.0 LTO of three months or longer (90 days) does not cost you anything. For more ELHT information, go to etfo.ca/benefits. There is an FAQ section that should answer many of your questions and also has the costing document for LTOs of less than 1.0.

SCEOT members need to enrol by **June 2nd**, although the emails state May 2nd. The date should have been changed in OTIP’s system to May 18th, but will change to June 2nd.
